Hotels/Motels, Apartments, Nursing Homes/Assisted Living Facilities, & Hospitals (Payable at time Building Permit is issued)

Hotels/Motels: (Multiply the number of rooms in the hotel/motel by .35 by the amount set forth for a 3/4 inch line).

Apartments: (Multiply the number of apartments in the complex by .50 by the amount set forth for a 3/4 inch line).

Nursing Homes/Assisted Living Facilities: (Multiply the number of rooms in the Nursing Home/Assisted Living Facilities by .30 by the amount set forth for a 3/4 inch line).

Hospitals: (Multiply the number of rooms in the Hospital by .50 by the amount set forth for a 3/4 inch line).

Section 1.02

DEPOSITS FOR UTILITY SERVICES

- a) A minimum deposit of \$103.09 will be charged for water meter sizes up to 1". Meter sizes of 1" and larger will be no less than 1½ times the minimum charge for each meter or the average estimated usage, whichever is greater.

- b) The maximum deposit at an address will not be in excess of 1½ times the average bill rendered or the estimated bill whichever is greater during the past twelve (12) months. If service is discontinued for non-payment, the deposit will automatically revert to a deposit as described in Section 1.01.

- c) Each account requires a deposit and service fee, regardless of the number of accounts or properties the customer has with Bessemer Utilities.

- d) When service is upgraded or renewed, the current deposit amount for electric and water must be upgraded. This includes name changes, reconnects, etc.

- e) Final bills for refunds or payment due of \$1.00 or less will not be processed.

- f) Finalized accounts will be reviewed for outstanding balances. Credit balances will be transferred to a customer's inactive account if there is an outstanding balance or if there is not an outstanding balance, if the customer has an active account the credit will be transferred to the active account. If the customer does not have an account to transfer the credit to a check will be issued for the credit balance.

Section 1.03 **RATE SCHEDULE - BESSEMER WATER SERVICE**

All water furnished except that used for the extinguishment of fire shall be sold by meter measurement, at the following scheduled rates, plus the availability charges as hereinafter provided:

RESIDENTIAL RATES

Monthly

Charges are measured in cubic feet; \$3.32 per 100 cu. ft. plus availability.

AVAILABILITY CHARGES

Monthly

5/8 inch meter	\$19.29
3/4 inch meter	\$19.29
1 inch meter	\$31.83
2 inch meter	\$108.64

If a meter serves more than one unit, the availability charge for a 3/4" meter will apply to each additional unit. Example: Three units on one meter— availability charge will be 3 times the monthly or availability charge for the actual meter size, whichever is greater.

COMMERCIAL RATES

Monthly

Charges are measured in cubic feet; \$3.32 per 100 cu. ft. plus availability.

If a meter serves more than one commercial unit, the availability charge for a 3/4" meter will apply to each additional unit.

Trailer parks will be charged by the total number of available lots or pads, multiplied by 70% times the rate for a 3/4 meter, or by the size of the master meter serving the park, whichever is greater.

FIRE PROTECTION

PUBLIC: \$214.45 per year or \$17.88 per month per hydrant.

SPRINKLER HEADS: \$275.60 per year or \$22.96 per month up to 500 head increments.
